

Notice to our valued Tamarac customers. Please review your bulk collection details.



BULK TRASH ACCEPTED

- Household Goods - furniture, mattresses, carpets (bundled and tied, not to exceed four (4) feet in length and fifty (50) pounds in weight), and other items normally found in the household. White Goods, i.e. washer, dryer, stove, refrigerator, air conditioners are collected.
- Miscellaneous Loose Bulk Trash Items: (i.e. concrete rubble, rock, gravel, etc.) must be set out in a container with the weight of the contents not to exceed fifty (50) pounds.
- Glass Items: All glass items must be placed in a sturdy rigid container(s) for safe collection. Do not place glass items in with your regular bulk items. Instead, place the glass items adjacent to the bulk items for separate handling.
- Incidental Debris from self-home improvement projects is permitted.
- Sink basin, toilet, small cabinets, closet shelving, minor self-home improvement items.
- Only Resident generated repair debris will be collected.
- Contractors must remove any debris they generate.

YARD WASTE

May be placed in the roll-out cart. Excess yard trash not placed in a roll-out cart must meet the following requirements.

- The weight shall not exceed fifty (50) pounds
- The material must be less than four (4) feet in length and less than four (4) inches in diameter (single piece)
- The material shall be neatly stacked, tied or secured in such a manner that prevents spillage when collected.
- Contractors / Landscapers must remove any debris they generate

BULK TRASH NOT ACCEPTED

- Construction Debris: Construction or building materials, from commercial contractor generated work, is not accepted. Contact WM customer service for removal options at (954) 974-7500.
- Automobile or marine: Parts, engines, etc.
- Miscellaneous: Loose dirt, rock or sod will not be collected. Must be properly containerized.
- Motor vehicles, trailers, comparable bulky items or machinery or equipment, highly flammable substances, hazardous waste, sludges, manure, explosives & ordinances, and any other material that cannot be lawfully be accepted at the designated facility.

NOTE:

Bulk set-out not to exceed 3 cubic yards per collection
